

# immunisation timetable 2011



If you require vaccinations for travel purposes, contact Travel Clinic Advisory on 1300 369 359 or refer to [www.health.vic.gov.au/immunisation/travel](http://www.health.vic.gov.au/immunisation/travel) for a travel vaccination clinic near you.

If you have recently moved into the Knox municipality from overseas, interstate or another municipality, prior to attending a public immunisation session, please contact Council's Health Services on 9298 8000 to determine whether your child/children's immunisation history is up to date.

## on the day of immunisation:

- Bookings are not required.
- Ensure person being immunised is well and does not have a temperature of 38.5°C or higher.
- Please bring your Medicare card and *Child Health Record* book to the session.
- Non-standard vaccines are available on a fee-for-service basis. Vaccines can be purchased either at Council's offices or at the immunisation session via EFTPOS.

## after immunisation:

- It is important to remain at the venue for 15 minutes after immunisation for observation.
- For side effects, refer to the purple flyer, *Common Reactions to Immunisation* which is given to you at the session.
- If reaction to a vaccine is severe or persists for periods longer than specified in the purple flyer *Common Reactions to Immunisation*, please notify your doctor or hospital.
